WEBSITE PRIVACY STATEMENT

Coega Development Corporation (CDC) Commitment

CDC is committed to respecting and protecting your right to privacy in line with section 14 of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996 (“the Constitution”) and the Protection of Personal Information Act 4 of 2013 (“POPIA”).

Accordingly, CDC is committed to your right to view and request copies, deletion and/or modification of the personal information that CDC collect from you.

Set out below, CDC explain what personal information CDC collect, how CDC collect it, why CDC collect it and how CDC use it. This policy does not apply to other parties’ websites that may be linked to or from our site, as well as social media platforms that may have their own privacy policies.

Collection of Personal Information

CDC collect personal information in two main ways: (i) actively from you; and/or (ii) passively from the device that you use to access and navigate through our site.

In relation to the active collection of personal information, this may include requiring you to submit certain information to register for a particular service, request to receive information or participate in a particular activity; answer specific questions, for instance through a feedback form or questionnaire; or maintaining a record of correspondence.

In relation to the passive collection of information, this may include the use of server loggers, cookies or anonymous identifiers. This enables our system to recognise you when you next visit CDC site and improve our service to you.

Personal information may only be processed if it is adequate, relevant and not excessive, given the purpose for which it is processed. Furthermore, CDC is committed to protecting personal information and take steps to ensure that the personal information is complete, accurate, not misleading and updated where necessary.

Storage and Usage of Personal Information

CDC take appropriate, reasonable technical and organisational measures to secure the integrity and confidentiality of personal information in our possession or under our control by taking relevant steps to prevent the loss of, damage to or unauthorised destruction of personal information or unlawful access to or processing of personal information, having due regard to generally accepted information security practices and procedures. CDC note, however, that there may nevertheless be risks associated with the sharing of personal information.

CDC will not use the personal information that you provide to us in a manner inconsistent with the purposes for which it was provided. Furthermore, CDC do not sell, rent or lease personal information.

Records of personal information are not retained for longer than is necessary unless there are appropriate grounds to do so, such as it being authorised by law. The CDC will destroy, delete or de-identify a record of personal information as soon as reasonably practicable after its retention is no longer authorised.

Data Transfers

The data that CDC collect may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside of South Africa. CDC will seek to ensure that the personal information remains within jurisdictions that have adequate protections for personal information, or that CDC have agreements in place to seek to ensure legally enforceable commitments to protect the personal information transferred.

Requests for Deletion or Correction

Data subjects may request the CDC to correct or delete their personal information that is inaccurate, irrelevant, excessive, out of date, incomplete or misleading by following the procedures prescribed by the CDC from time to time.
