

CONSTRUCTION OF INFRASTRUCTURE FOR CEMENT CRUSHER PLANT (OSHO) AND KENAKO CONCRETE BATCHING PLANT IN ZONE 5 OF THE IDZ

CONTRACT NO: CDC/164/18

The Coega Project is a multi-billion rand initiative consisting of an Industrial Development Zone (IDZ) and a deepwater Port situated in Port Elizabeth. The initiative aims to position South Africa as a Platform for global manufacturing and export through foreign and local investments. This process forms part of the Coega Development Corporation's (CDC) overall development of infrastructure for the Coega IDZ.

INVITATION AND SCOPE OF SERVICES

The Coega Development Corporation is inviting capable and competent contractors to submit tenders for the construction of Infrastructure for Cement Crusher Plant (OSHO) and Kenako Concrete Batching Plant in Zone 5 of the IDZ. The project covers the construction of a water pipe line, sewer pipe line, access roads, storm water reticulation including all associated earthworks, etc.

CONDITIONS

- (a) Tenderers shall be registered with the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) and should have a CIDB Contractor grading of 6CE or higher. Potential bidders with a grading of 5 CE PE will not be eligible for this tender.
- (b) CDC Procurement Policy shall apply.
- (c) Public Finance Management Act (PFMA) Sections 36 and 49 shall apply.
- (d) Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act, 2000: Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2017 will apply.
- (e) The score will be determined as follows:
 - (i) Price -80,
 - (ii) BBBEE Score -20.
- (f) Bidders must confirm their company registration with CIPC (formerly CIPRO) as CDC will not award any tender to any business that appears on the CIPC List of de-registered businesses;
- (g) Bidders with less than 51% black shareholding (QSEs & Generics) are to submit a valid SANAS Accredited B-BBEE Verification Certificate (with the full applicable B-BBEE Elements). Bidders with more than 51% black shareholding (EMEs & QSEs) are to submit a sworn affidavit stamped and signed by the Commissioner of Oaths as per the DTI B-BBEE template. In case of JV a consolidated B-BBEE certificate must be submitted as well as individual BBBEE Certificates/ affidavit of their entities to confirm the type of the enterprise).
- (h) Proof of registration with Treasury's Centralized Supplier Database (CSD) or provide a Treasury CSD registration number e.g. MAAAO
- (i) Bidders will be evaluated based on functionality and must meet a minimum threshold of 60%. Only those who meet the minimum threshold will be acceptable.
- (j) CDC will only award the tender to a bidder who is tax compliant. The tax compliance status of the bidders will be verified through CSD and SARS website.
- (k) In case of 7CE or higher the contractor must complete and sign FORM K: EME/SMME and LEP Target Form (Main Contractor to meet 38% SMME/EME participation of tender value, excluding VAT, escalation, etc.
- (l) Bidders are required to meet the minimum stipulated threshold for Local Production and Content as per Appendix A in the tender document. Bidders to ensure that they submit a completed and signed SBD 6.2 Form and Annexure C, D and E.
- (m) CDC will not award more than two active projects to one bidder, unless one project has reached 80% completion stage and beyond. Capacity assessment may be conducted in an event that the recommended bidder is the only responsive service provider and has already been awarded two contracts,

Bid documents can be collected from the CDC's Main Office, Coega Business Centre, Cnr Alcyon Rd and Zibuko Street, Zone 1, Coega IDZ, Port Elizabeth from 10h00 on Friday, 29 June 2018. A non-refundable bid fee of R 500.00 should be deposited to CDC, FNB Account 621 541 94361 Branch Code 261 050 or by bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of the CDC, is required upon collection of the bid documents. No tender document will be available at the Briefing Meeting.

A mandatory briefing meeting and site inspection will be conducted at **10h00 on Friday, 06 July 2018**, at CDC BPO Building, Zone 4, Coega IDZ, Port Elizabeth. where representatives from the Coega Development Corporation and the Consultants will meet prospective Tenderers.

One original of the completed bid document shall be placed in a sealed envelope clearly marked: **"CDC/164/18 - Construction of Infrastructure for Cement Crusher Plant (OSHO) and Kenako Concrete Batching Plant in Zone 5 of the IDZ**. The closing date and time for the receipt of completed bid documents is **12h00 on Monday, 23 July 2018**. Bids are to be placed in the tender box at the CDC main office Coega Business Centre, Cnr Alcyon Rd and Zibuko Street, Zone 1, Coega IDZ, Port Elizabeth. Bids will be opened in public and no late submissions will be considered.

Failure to provide any mandatory information required in this Bid will result in the submissions being deemed null and void and shall be considered non-responsive. Telegraphic, telexed, facsimiled or e-mail submissions will not be accepted.

No telephonic or any other form of communication with any other CDC member of staff, other than the named individual below, relating to this request for bid will be permitted.
