

THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE BAIC BULK ELECTRICAL SUPPLY CONTRACT NO CDC/369/16

The Coega Project is a multi-billion rand initiative consisting of an Industrial Development Zone (IDZ) and a deepwater Port situated in Port Elizabeth. The initiative aims to position South Africa as a Platform for global manufacturing and export through foreign and local investments. This process forms part of the Coega Development Corporation's (CDC) overall development of infrastructure for the Coega IDZ.

INVITATION AND SCOPE OF WORK

The CDC is inviting capable and competent Service Providers to submit tenders for the Construction of 132kV Power lines and a 132/11kV Substation. This project covers the strengthening of the Electrical Infrastructure within the Coega IDZ to provide power for a new vehicle manufacturing facility, viz. the BIAC project. This contract includes the design and construction of a new 132/11kV substation in Zone 1 of the Coega IDZ as well as the construction of a double circuit power line to connect the substation into an existing 132kV ring.

Conditions

- (a) Tenders shall be registered with the Construction Industry Development Board (CIDB) and should have a CIDB Contractor grading of 8EP or higher. However, development enterprises with 7EP PE grading may also submit tenders. Entities who intend submitting a bid as a Joint Venture must ensure that their combined grading meets the required CIDB Grading
- (b) Preference will be given to respondents who comply with the CDC's Procurement Policy & Procedures.
- (c) Preferential Procurement Policy Framework Act (PPPFA) principles shall apply, whereby submissions will be evaluated according to the provisions of that Act and the Public Finance Management Act (PFMA) Sections 36 and 49.
- (d) Bidders must submit a valid BBBEE Verification Certificate from SANAS accredited Verification Agencies or from a Registered Auditor approved by the Independent Regulatory Board of Auditors (IRBA) in order to be eligible for empowerment points. The QSE and EME may submit a sworn affidavit signed and stamped by a commissioner of oaths;
- (e) For Functionality Scoring, bidders have to achieve a minimum threshold of 60% in order to be considered for next stage of evaluation;
- (f) The scores will be determined as follows:

(i) Price	-	90
(ii) BBBEE Status	-	10

Bid documents can be collected from the new CDC's Main Office, Training Room, Coega Business Centre, Cnr Alcyon Rd and Zibuko Street, Zone 1, Coega IDZ, Port Elizabeth from 09H00, Friday 03 March 2017. No documents will be available or issued at the Briefing Session and should therefore be collected timeously beforehand.

A non-refundable bid fee of R 1500.00 per set of documents drawn, payable by bank guaranteed cheque made out in favour of the CDC, or by means of electronic transfers are to be made to Account Name: CDC; Standard Bank, Account No: 080008070, Branch: Pickering Street. Proof of deposit is required upon collection of the bid documents. NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED.

A mandatory briefing meeting will be conducted on **Monday, 13 March 2017 at 10h00**. Representatives from the Coega Development Corporation will meet prospective Bidders at the CDC Human Capital Solution Office, R102 Old Coega Road, Zone 4, Coega IDZ, Port Elizabeth.

One original completed bid document shall be placed in a sealed envelope clearly marked: **"CDC/369/16 - TENDER: "THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE BAIC BULK ELECTRICAL SUPPLY"**. The closing date and time for the receipt of completed bids is **Monday, 27 March 2017, 12h00** at the tender box in the reception area of the CDC main office Coega Business Centre, Cnr Alcyon Rd and Zibuko Street, Zone 1, Coega IDZ, Port Elizabeth. Bids will be opened in public and no late proposals will be considered.

Failure to provide any mandatory information required in this bid will result in the submissions being deemed non-responsive.

Proof of registration with Treasury's Centralized Supplier Database (CSD) or provide a Treasury CSD registration number e.g. MAAA0...; contractors and service providers have a responsibility to make sure that they are Tax compliant by the closing date of the bid they are tendering for and also remain Tax compliant during the evaluation period. The contractors/service providers Tax Status would be verified through CSD.

Telegraphic, telexed, facsimiled or e-mail submissions will not be accepted.

No telephonic or any other form of communication with any other CDC member of staff, other than the named individual below, relating to this request for tender will be permitted.
